

Highlights from the hygiene concept of Burg Rieneck

(distilled to the best of our knowledge from the countless state rules with status from 01/12/2022)

The **2G rule** currently applies to the Covid19 pandemic at the castle:

- All guests must be **either vaccinated or recovered** - this *excludes children up to the age of 6 and underage students* who take regular tests in subject to school attendance
- Appropriate **proof** must be provided upon arrival and will be documented by the castle or an authorized representative.

We also recommend that all organizers adopt a *voluntary 2G+* rule, i. e. to submit a current rapid test or PCR test upon arrival.

The castle reserves the right to request a corresponding test itself.

Should a test come back positive or should symptoms of illness occur during the stay, the affected person must leave promptly and must be isolated until then.

Indoors, guests over the age of 16 are generally **obliged to wearing an FFP2 mask**, for younger people and employees of the castle the so-called medical mask is considered sufficient, children under 6 years old do not need to wear a mask.

No mask is required

- at fixed standing or seating areas, if a minimum distance of 1.5 m to people who do not belong to your own household, is guaranteed
- in the bedrooms
- in the dining room, as long as you are seated

Please wash your hands before each visit to the dining room or disinfect them when entering.

Please always ensure the minimum distance to others.

We ask all our guests to abide by these rules to keep us well and safe throughout this pandemic.
